The Hon'ble Supreme Court of India lifts suspension of the Environment Clearance on GMR Goa International Airport

- *Judgement permits construction of Greenfield International Airport at Mopa in Goa*

New Delhi/Panaji, January 16, 2020: GMR Goa International Airport Limited (GGIAL), a subsidiary of GMR Infrastructure Limited informed that today, January 16 2020, the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in its judgment has lifted the suspension on Environment Clearance imposed *vide* its Order dated March 29, 2019 on construction of new greenfield airport at Mopa, Goa.

This in effect will result in resumption of the construction activities at the project site to build a greenfield international airport at MOPA, Goa, by GGIAL in compliance with the conditions imposed under various Environment Clearances and adoption of zero carbon program voluntarily assured by GMR Group, to be overseen by National Environmental Engineering Research Institute.

This is a leap of faith reposed on the GMR Group which has always been dedicated towards maintaining the balance of sustainable development. The commitment of GMR Group to ensure compliance of best practices in maintaining and developing world class airports has been reaffirmed.

A GMR Group Spokesperson said, ***"We welcome the verdict of the Honourable Supreme Court of India. We plan to commence work for the new airport in Goa soon, in compliance with the orders of the Honourable Supreme Court. The new airport at MOPA is expected to enhance tourism and employment opportunities in Goa and open up new avenues for boosting the economy of the State. GMR Group assures its continued services towards nation building."***

GMR Infrastructure Limited, a leading global infrastructure conglomerate with interests in Airport, Energy, Transportation and Urban Infrastructure, is listed on Indian Stock Exchanges.
