## **GMR Airports wins North Goa's Greenfield Mopa Airport**

- Emerges as the highest bidder in a closely contested bid with 5 bidders having prequalified viz., GMR Airports, Airports Authority of India, Essel-Incheon, GVK and Hiranandani-Vinci
- Final bids were submitted by GMR Airports, AAI and Essel-Incheon consortium
- The airport is to be built through BOT model for a period of 40 years, extendable by 20 years
- Reinforces GMR's position as a globally credible and financially strong airport developer
- Airport to have Hybrid Till with 30% cross subsidy

**New Delhi, August 26, 2016**: GMR Airports Limited (GAL), a subsidiary of GMR Infrastructure Limited has won the international competitive bid for development and operation of Mopa Greenfield Airport in North Goa. The concession period for the Greenfield project will be 40 years with a possible extension of another 20 years through a bid process. The airport will be built under the BOT (Build Operate Transfer) model.

GMR won the bid through a closely contested competitive bid process with Airports Authority emerging as the second highest bidder followed by the consortium of Essel Infra-Incheon emerging third.

The letter of award is expected to be issued within 60 days, while signing of concession agreement will be done within 45 days from the date of issuance of award letter.

Commenting on the development, Mr. Srinivas Bommidala, Chairman Airports, GMR Group, said, "GMR Airports Limited is delighted to have won the bid for the development and operation of Mopa Greenfield airport in Goa. We take this opportunity to reiterate our commitment to contributing to infrastructure development of India and assure the central and state governments that we will deliver an airport worthy of the state of Goa well within the project timelines. The bid win also reinforces GMR Group's credentials as the largest airport developer and operator in India and one of the top 5 private airport developers across the world."



The regulatory regime for the concession will be hybrid till with 30% cross subsidy. The concession offers 232 acres of land for commercial city side development for a period of 60 years.

GMR Group owns and operates India's Delhi Airport which is presently ranked as World's No.1 airport in its passenger category as well as Hyderabad airport which has been consistently ranked among World's top three airports in its category over the last 7 years. The Group had constructed Delhi airport's Terminal 3 in a record time of 37 months and Istanbul's Sabiha Gokcen airport in 18 months, which is a world record. GMR Infrastructure in partnership with Megawide Construction Corporation is also developing Mactan Cebu International Airport (MCIA) in Philippines.
