### **Hyderabad Airport**



- Hyderabad Airport traffic continues upward growth trajectory
  - Handled highest-ever monthly Pax traffic in May 2024
  - ✓ In May 2024, Pax traffic crossed 2.3 mn Pax mark up 11% YoY
    - Domestic Traffic ▲ 10% YoY
    - International Traffic ▲14% YoY
  - ✓ Pax traffic transcended sustainably above 2 mn Pax every month since October 2023
  - ✓ Handled highest ever single day Pax traffic ~82,300 Pax on May 18, 2024
  - ✓ Handled highest-ever single day ATMs of 548 on May 04, 2024
- GMR Hyderabad Air Cargo Expansion: Bhumi Pujan ritual performed on May 18, 2024 marked the beginning of the construction of new Cargo Terminal 2 with an initial annual capacity of 50,000 MT in Phase 1 (FY25); designed for future expansion to 100,000 MT in Phase 2
